Veterans Day Schedule: The City of League City offices - to include City Hall, Helen Hall Library, Hometown Heroes Park and most municipal offices - will be closed on Wednesday, Nov. 11, in observance of Veteran's Day.

The City of League City is proud to honor local veterans, servicemen and women, and their families during a special ceremony on Wednesday, November 11, 2015. The League City Veterans Day Ceremony will take place at 10 a.m. at Chester Davis Sportsplex at 1251 League City Parkway.

The City invites citizens and their families to attend the ceremony and enjoy the facilities while reflecting on the sacrifices made by our own hometown heroes.

All City emergency services and parks (excluding Hometown Heroes Park Building) will operate as usual throughout the holiday.

Residential and commercial recycling routes will run at their regularly scheduled time.

City offices will re-open on Thursday, Nov. 12.

Annual Arbor Day Celebration: The City of League City will host their annual Arbor Day Celebration on Nov. 7 at 10 a.m. at League Park (512 Second St.).

The event will include a brief ceremony with a declaration from the Mayor, Lorax themed treats and activities for kids, educational and demonstration tables and a free adopt a tree event.

Park Street Closure Begins Monday: Beginning Monday Park St. from FM 518 to 3rd St. will be closed for resurfacing. The City anticipates all the resurfacing to be complete by the week of Nov. 16, weather permitting.

Road Repairs on South Shore Blvd. and League City Parkway: Beginning this week the street department is moving forward with Teamwork Construction to make a number of repairs to South Shore Blvd. between FM 518 and FM 2094. There are a number of locations that have failed and will be removed and replaced. During the repair process, lanes will need to be closed and the City encourages the public to drive defensively as it works to improve the roadway and keep it safe for all motorists.

In addition, the City has also scheduled the repair of the intersection of League City Parkway and Hobbs Road for repair.

The City anticipates all the repairs to be complete by the first week of Dec. weather permitting.

Emergency Drainage Repair West NASA Road: Over the weekend of Oct. 24, a 54-inch corrugated metal drainage pipe (CMP) between West NASA Road and the canal began collapsing between two houses and created two large sink holes. The City of League City televised a portion of the line and determined there were a number of areas deteriorating and subject to continuing failures. Based on the video obtained and the existing two failures, the City determined this 30-year old line was in need of immediate replacement to avoid damage to the adjacent structures and maintain an appropriate drainage way for the storm water runoff.

The street department has temporarily alleviated the sink holes with cement stabilized sand and is moving forward with an emergency repair of this 145-foot long drainage line. The work is expected to start next week and be completed prior to Thanksgiving. \$110,000 project will be brought to Council for ratification of the expenditure at the Dec. 8, 2015 Council Meeting.

Marbella Signal Activation: The Marbella contractor is working to complete the signal installation at League City Parkway and Isla Vista so the residents of Marbella have an access point to League City Parkway. It is anticipated the contractor will complete all of the signal items, signs and striping by the end of next week (Nov. 13). The pre-turn-on inspection and signal activation should then occur the first part of the following week (Nov. 17 and 18).

Ceramic and Pottery Classes for Seniors: The Parks Recreation Department will continue to offer Ceramic and Pottery Art classes for seniors ages 55 and older at the Ceramic and Pottery Center, located at 900 Hwy 3 North in League City. Classes are free of charge for residents to include free transportation for seniors from Hometown Heroes Park. Classes are set for Oct. 28, Nov. 4 and Nov. 18 from 1 to 3 p.m. and 6 to 8 p.m. Participants will learn the basics of ceramic and pottery art, with hands-on instruction in a fun and relaxed atmosphere.
